History of 10th June

- ◆ 1246: Naseeruddin Muhammad Shah I became the ruler of Delhi.
- ♦ 1966: The Indian Air Force's fighter aircraft MiG was manufactured in Nashik district of Maharashtra.
- ♦ 2003 : NASA's Mangalyaan Rover was launched.
- 1972: The fully air-conditioned vessel Harshvardhan was launched from Margao port in Mumbai.
- ▶ 1996 : An organic products factory was destroyed in Baghdad.

Current Affairs Related to 10th June 2024

- Railways will install optical fiber based system to detect elephants crossing the tracks. This is part of the latest measures to prevent elephant deaths on the tracks. Southern Railways are installing this system for the first time after its successful implementation in four divisions of Northeast Frontier Railway. The work will be done on war footing at a cost of Rs 15.4 crore. There will be no cameras for IDS. It will depend on acoustics and optics.
- ♦ The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India and the Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority have jointly developed the Integrated Bharat Organic. This India will be organic and organic India will replace the people. The main objective of the new logo is to bring uniformity in organic product regulation. Bharat Organic denotes NPOP compliance, while Organic India was for FSSAI certified organic products.
- ISRO through its Vikram Sarabhai Space Center has introduced Flow software, a computational fluid rotation tool, which aims to underpin the aerodynamic design and analysis for aerospace vision. RANS is the acronym for Parallel Quadrant Solver for Aerospace Vehicle Aero-Thermo Diamond Analysis, which is designed to simulate both external and internal flows on a variety of launches, including winged and non-winged re-entry.
- Mumbai Police's counter-terrorism unit Force One chief Krishna Prakash has received the prestigious annual Hindi Sahitya Bharti Award. This award was given during the Sabme Ram Shashwat Shri Ram Multicultural Festival in Mumbai. The Hindi Sahitya Bharati initiative brings together intellectuals on a common platform to enhance cultural and literary endeavours.
- Adani One, the digital platform of Adani Group, and ICICI Bank have partnered to launch two diverse co-branded credit cards.

- Three MoUs for industry academic collaboration were signed by Gati Shakti University. To enhance the partnership between industry and academia, Jacobs, Nokia and Placer India have joined hands with Indian Railways Gati Shakti University Vadodara. Three MoUs were signed at Rail Bhawan New Delhi. With this, students will be job ready by their final year in GSV Institute.
- The third advance estimate of production of major agricultural crops for the year 2023-2024 has been released by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. From the last agricultural year, Zaid season has been separated from Rabi season and included in the third advance estimate. Therefore, this third advance estimate of area, production and yield includes Kharif, Rabi and Zaid seasons.
- The Indian Council of Medical Research has invited expressions of interest for the manufacturing of hydroxyurea for the treatment of sickle cell disease in children in India. India has the highest incidence of sickle cell disease in South Asia, and more than one million sickle cell affected individuals live in India. Sickle cell diseases are one of the most common monogenic disorders of hemoglobin. Hydroxyurea, a myelosuppressive agent, is an effective drug for treating patients with sickle cell disease and thalassemia.
- ♦ Poet and playwright Siddalinga Pattanashetty has been awarded the prestigious Gudleppa Award for 2024 by the Gudleppa Hallikeri Memorial Foundation. Pattanashetty will be the 19th recipient of this award. The award consists of a sum of Rs 25000 and a memento.
- Netherlands emerges as India's third largest export destination in 2023-2024. India mainly exported petroleum products, electrical goods, chemicals and pharmaceuticals to the Netherlands. India's trade surplus with the Netherlands increased from \$13 billion to \$17.4 billion in the last financial year.
