- National Internet Exchange of India is preparing to launch the BhashaNet portal during the upcoming Universal Acceptance Day. The initiative marks a collaborative effort between the National Internet Exchange of India and the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology to advance digital inclusion and linguistic diversity in India. With the support of the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers and the Internet Conventions Division of Dumpuzzle. Gives importance and strength to the day.
- ♦ DBS Bank India has pledged to offer US\$250 million to India's Royal Shlok Mantra to support newage star-ups and boost innovation. The Ministry has advised all social media influencers and supporters to refrain from advertising or promoting offshore online betting and gambling platforms. The ministry has also advised them to refrain from surrogate advertisements of offshore online betting and platforms.
- ◆ Indian table tennis player Sathiyan Gnanasekaran has won the men's singles title at the WTT Feeder Beirut tournament in Lebanon. World No. 103 Sathiyan defeated World No. 74 Manav Vikas Thakkar in the final.
- South Korea hosted the third Summit for Democracy. Ministerial conferences, multi-stakeholder roundtables, civil society and youth events, and the Leaders' Plenary Meeting were part of this summit. It is an initiative by US President Joe Biden to discuss ways to stop the democratic erosion of rights and freedoms. Representatives from more than 30 countries participated in it.
- Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal was arrested by ED. Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has been arrested in a money laundering case related to liquor policy. He is the first Chief Minister of India to be arrested while in office. Earlier, leaders like Lalu Yadav, Jayalalitha and Hemant Soren had resigned from the post of Chief Minister before their arrest.
