History of April 20

- ♦ 1712: Jahandar Shah deposed on the throne of Delhi.
- ◆ 1960: The first jet aircraft, Boeing 707, joined Air India's fleet.
- ◆ 1971 : India won its first Test cricket match.
- **2006**: India announced the establishment of its first foreign military base in Tajikistan.
- 2011 : Indian Space Research Organisation's satellite launch vehicle PSLV launched three satellites into space.

Current Affairs Related to 20 April

- The IMF re-appointed Kristalina Georgieva as Managing Director for the next five-year term. Kristalina Georgieva will be the Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund for a second five-year term. Georgieva is the second woman to head the IMF and the first from an emerging market economy. She will continue to serve as Managing Director after her current tenure ends on September 30, 2024.
- The government has set a target of producing 170 million tonnes of coal from captive and commercial coal blocks in the current financial year. Captive and commercial coal blocks produced 147.12 million tonnes of dry fuel in FY 2024. This is 26% more than the 116 metric tons produced in FY 2023.
- ◆ IMGI and Bank of India ICICI are targeted at salaried and self-employed individuals in the residential sector. Bharat Mortgage Corporation has entered into a mortgage venture with Bank of India to introduce mortgage mortgage-backed home loan documents. This assistance targets salaried and self-employed people in the Nagaland region, with the aim of reaching homeownership.
- The US President's Gold Volunteer Service Award was presented to Indian Jain spiritual leader Lokesh Muni. This award has been given to him for his contribution to public welfare and humanity. Senior Democratic Congressman Brandt Sherman presented the Presidential Award Golden Shield and Certificate of Honor to Lokesh Muni at the US Capitol.
- ♦ According to the latest data from the Global Forest Watch monitoring project, 2.33 million hectares of tree cover has been lost since 2000. This is equivalent to a six percent reduction in tree cover during this period. According to the data, 95 percent of the loss of tree cover in India between 2013 and 2023 occurred within natural forests.

- Madhya Pradesh is the leader in tree plantation under Green Credit Scheme with 954 hectares. To implement the Centre's Green Credit Programme, Madhya Pradesh has taken a lead role in approving over 500 land parcels spanning 4980 hectares across 10 states for tree plantation in the last two months. Along with three other states, these states have identified more than 10,000 hectares of land for the programme. Till now, Madhya Pradesh has approved maximum 954 hectares of degraded forest land for tree plantation/greening exercise.
- The IMD has predicted that June to September will see 6% more rainfall than the annual average of 87 cm for these months. Last year, El Nino affected India's monsoon by 6%. El Nino, a warming of the central Pacific, is predicted to turn into La Niño by the second half of the monsoon season this year.
- Testing of foreign nationals receiving organ transplants in India has been ordered by the Central Government. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare demanded that officials of the respective states and union territories closely monitor these transplants. The ministry asked them to take appropriate action against any hospitals found violating the law. Transplants involving foreign persons will be examined by a designated authority under the Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act 1994.
- ♦ Delhi Airport has been named among the top 10 busiest airports in the world for 2023. Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport tops the list. Dubai and Dallas airports are at second and third place respectively.
- India's wholesale price inflation increased from 0.2% in February to 0.53% in March. Wholesale inflation has increased to the highest level in three months in March. Food Index 4.65: Increase in grain prices contributed to the increase in the food index in value terms.




