- ♦ 1659 : Aurangzeb, the ruler of the Mughal Empire, officially ascended the throne of Delhi.
- ◆ 1984 : Under Operation Blue Star, the Indian Army entered the Sikh religious place, the Golden Temple in Amritsar, Punjab.
- ◆ 1882 : About one million people died due to the Bombay cyclone and flood.
- ♦ 1972: World Environment Day started in 1972 with the World Environment Conference organized by the United Nations General Assembly.

Current Affairs Related to 5th June 2024

- Kerala has made a start by integrating Artificial Intelligence into its pages. The state plans to introduce modules on AI learning within the Information and Communication Technology curriculum for Class 7 students. The move will impact more than 4 million students across Kerala, who will now get the opportunity to delve deeper into the field of AI in the upcoming academic year, according to a campaign released by the Kerala Infrastructure and Technology for Education.
- ◆ India's premier mental health institute, National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences
 Bengaluru has been awarded the prestigious Nelson
 Mandela Prize for Health Objectives 2024 by the
 World Health Organization. The award recognizes
 individuals, awards and activities that have made
 significant contributions to health promotion.
- ♦ England's fast bowling all-rounder Braden Carse has been suspended from all forms of cricket for three months after being found guilty of breaching cricket rules. The 28-year-old placed 303 bets on various cricket matches between 2017 and 2019, leading to the charges against him. After pleading guilty, Carse was initially given a 16-month ban, 13 months of which were suspended.
- India's core sectors, which include coal, steel, manufactured, rods, power, natural gas, refinery products and crude oil, witnessed a significant growth of 6.2% in the month of April, reflecting positive momentum in key industries. This growth is in contrast to the growth of 4.6% in April 2023, driven by strong performance in sectors like steel, power and natural gas.
- ♦ Briham Soma, a 12-year-old Indian-American 7th grade student from Florida, won the Scripps National Spelling Bee by spelling 29 words correctly in a tiebreaker. Brahut Soma won the US\$50,000 contest and several prizes. Children continued to dominate this competition.

- In a significant step, the Indian Boxing Federation has agreed to join World Boxing, a new governing body after the International Olympic Committee asked it not to recognize the International Boxing Federation. Made later. The move comes ahead of the ongoing World Olympic Qualifiers in Bangkok, where the BFI will be ratified by the WB Executive Board. It has become necessary to join the World Bank to ensure the participation of Indian boxers in the Olympics.
- The Reserve Bank of India has presented its annual report. In this report, the Central Bank said that India's growth is likely to increase by 7 percent in the current financial year. RBI has estimated the Indian economy to grow at the rate of seven percent in the current financial year. This will be the fastest pace of growth among the major companies in the world.
- ◆ Badminton star PV Sindhu has become the brand ambassador for tobacco control. Shri Apoorva Chandra emphasized on the proactive approach of the Government to implement measures at various levels, local, national, regional and global to significantly reduce the prevalence of tobacco and the principles of exposure to tobacco thereby promoting healthy society. meet. He unveiled key focus areas for tobacco control initiatives in 2024.
- The fiscal deficit of the government was 5.63 percent in the last financial year. This is slightly less than the estimate of 5.8 percent expressed in the Union Budget. In actual, fiscal deficit i.e. the difference between expenditure and revenue was Rs 16.53 lakh crore. The government had estimated the GDP to be 5.8% in the official estimate of the interim budget 2023-2024 presented on February 1.
- ♦ The Government of India has increased the upper limit of unemployment and mortality from Rs 20 lakh to Rs 25 lakh from January 1, 2024.


