Current Affairs Related to 27 December

- Actor Amitabh Bachchan announced to become the owner of Mumbai team in the Indian Street Premier League. ISPL is India's first tennis ball T10 cricket tournament to be played inside the stadium, according to a press release. The first such tournament in the country will be organized in Mumbai from March 2 to 9. Amitabh Bachchan will help those playing cricket on street corners to play in the stadium and showcase their talent. He has become the owner of the Mumbai team in the Indian Street Premier League.
- Indian Navy has joined hands with Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur to enhance its technology. An MoU has been formally signed at Naval Headquarters in New Delhi. Under this, technology development and innovative solutions will be taken forward. Assistant Chief of Staff Real Admiral K Srinivas and Director of IIT Kanpur Professor S Ganesh have signed the agreement. IIT Kanpur Director Professor A Ganesh said that this will increase strategic partnership.
- Shares of State Bank of India have reached new highs, rising by a massive 17% in the last month to reach a record high of Rs 659.50. This surge has outperformed the market, with the S&P BSE Sensex and Nifty 50 up nearly 9% and the Nifty PSU Bank index up 14% during the same period.
- RBI has granted final authorization to Razorpay and Cashfree as payment aggregators, which will help them onboard new merchants and strengthen their dedication towards innovative payment solutions. Payment processing giants Razorpay and Cashfree have received final authorization from the Reserve Bank of India to operate as payment aggregators. This significant development comes after a year-long gap in onboarding new traders in compliance with the RBI advisory.
- ◆ India's October 2023 FDI reaches 21-month high of \$5.9 billion on strong inflows and low repatriations.

- Former US President Donald Trump has suffered a major setback in the US Capitol violence case. Donald Trump has been disqualified for the post of President by the Colorado Supreme Court. However, Republican Party presidential candidate Vivek Ramaswamy has reacted to Trump's disqualification.

- The central government issued an advisory to the states after the first case of JN.1 variant was detected in the country. The advisory directed the states to ensure effective compliance of the detailed and revised operational guidelines for COVID 19 surveillance strategy. States were also asked to ensure that there is adequate testing in all districts.
- ◆ The European Union (EU) has expressed disappointment over India's refusal to join interim mediation to resolve the ongoing dispute related to import duty on certain information and communication technology (ICT) products such as smartphones and components.


