History of 8th April

- ♦ 1929 : Revolutionaries Bhagat Singh and Batuk Veer Dutt had dropped the Delhi Assembly bomb.
- ◆ 1985 : The border war between India and Pakistan began, also known as the Second Kashmir War.
- 2008: States in Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka declared Sikhs a minority in their states.
- ◆ 1857: The soldiers of the rebellion of the First Indian War of Independence were hanged at Mangal Pavilion.

Current Affairs Related to 8th April

- A new and more user-friendly version of the grievance redressal system, SCORES 2.0, was launched by SEBI. The new version of SCORES will make the process more efficient through auto-routing, auto-escalation, monitoring and reduction in timelines. In SCORES 2.0, the time limit for redressal of complaints has been reduced to 21 days. Moreover, there will be two levels of review. The first level review will be conducted by the designated body and if the investor is dissatisfied, SEBI will conduct a second review.
- Adani Green Energy Limited announced that 2000 MW solar capacity has been commissioned at Khavra Solar Park in Gujarat. Now it is the first company in India to have more than 10000 MW renewable energy capacity. The company now has the largest operating portfolio in India with 10,934 MW. 2848 MW new renewable energy capacity added in FY 2024.
- The Bundelkhand region in Uttar Pradesh, locally known as Kathia Jenhu, has been awarded the prestigious Geographical Indication tag. In an important milestone for the agricultural scientist, the indigenous clay factory of the volcanic region of Uttar Pradesh, locally known as Kathiya Jenhu, has been awarded the coveted Geographical Indication tag.
- Guyana received two Dornier 228 aircraft from India-based aerospace and defense company Hindustan Aeronautics Limited to significantly enhance its defense capabilities. Two Dornier 228 aircraft were handed over to the Guyana Defense Force and arrived at Cheddi Jagan International Airport.
- ♦ India's manufacturing PMI reached a 16-year high of 59.1 in March. India's manufacturing industry has expanded rapidly in the last 16 years due to increasing demand. India's manufacturing PMI increased from 56.9 in February to 59.1 in March. PMI in January was 56.5.

- As per FSSAI directives, e-commerce platforms will have to accurately classify products listed as health and energy drinks on their websites. FSSAI said the main objective of this step is to increase clarity and transparency regarding the nature and functional benefits of these products. This will help consumers in taking decisions and avoid misinformation.
- ♦ Mirabai Chanu has become the only Indian weightlifter to qualify for the Paris Olympics 2024. Chanu finished third in Group B of the women's 49 kg competition and 11th overall. Chanu lifted a total weight of 184 kg in the World Cup.
- India achieved production of one billion tonnes of coal and lignite for the first time in the financial year 2023-2024. India's production has increased by 70% in the last ten years. India has set a target to stop importing coal by 2025-2026. When compared this financial year with the previous financial year, the percentage of imported coal used for blending has decreased.
- TRAI released a consultation paper on inputs for the formulation of National Broadcasting Policy-2024. According to the Ministry of Communications, broadcasting industry is an emerging industry. It has immense potential to support the expansion of the Indian economy. With the aim of establishing India as a global hub for content, this paper addresses the important concerns that often exist in the broadcasting industry.
