History of 2nd April

- ♦ 1679 : Mughal ruler Akbar abolished Jizya tax.
- ♦ 1984 : Astronaut Rakesh Sharma became the first Indian astronaut to go to space under the mission Soyuz T-11.
- ♦ 1849 : British Punjab was established.
- ◆ 2017: Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated to the nation the country's longest Chenani Nashri road tunnel in Jammu and Kashmir.
- ♦ 1720 : Peshwa Balaji Vishwanath died.
- ◆ 1942 : Congress rejected the Cripps Mission proposal.

Current Affairs Related to 2nd April

- Indian Council of Medical Research will issue evidence based criteria for prevention, screening, diagnosis and management of lung cancer. The Indian Council of Medical Research is set to launch a systematic review and meta analysis. This will play an important role in the management of lung cancer to guide clinical practice.
- The consultancy analyzed 465 refining assets. This puts approximately 21% of global refining capacity at risk of closure by 2023. The places most at risk are in Europe and China. About 3.9 million barrels per day of refining capacity is in critical condition and at risk of being destroyed. Eleven European sites account for 45% of all high-risk plants, according to the report.
- To achieve a major reform towards ease of doing business and self-reliance in the defense sector, a notification has been issued for restructuring of the Directorate General of Quality Assurance by the Department of Defense Production under the Ministry of Defence. Its objective is to increase the speed of quality assurance processes and tests and reduce unnecessary delays at various levels of decision making. This restructuring also led to changes in the quality assurance methodology following corporatization of OFB and the modified role of the Directorate General of Quality Assurance.
- Adani Ports and Special Zone, a subsidiary of Adani Group, has acquired 95% controlling interest in Gopalpur Port in Odisha. This deal worth Rs 3350 crore strengthens the position of Adani Ports and Special Zone, a subsidiary of Adani Group, in the ports and logistics sector.
- ♦ S. Raman has written the book From a Car Shed to the Corner Room and Beyond. The book gives a first-person account of his remarkable journey from a clerk in SBI to becoming the Chairman and Managing Director of Canara Bank and a full-time member of SEBI.

- According to a report, the annual revenue of the Indian gaming industry will increase from \$3.1 billion in 2023 to \$6 billion by 2028. According to India Gaming Report 2024 there will be 2028 million gamers, which was 144 million gamers in 2023. According to the report, the number of professional players will increase from 500 in 2023 to 2.5 times in 2028.
- ♦ The Election Commission of India is monitoring the election process through the CVigil app. The app lets citizens report violations of the model code of conduct and election expenditure by posting photos and videos. Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar said Cevigil empowers citizens to report violations with assured action within 100 minutes.
- ♦ Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India has designated three insurance companies as Domestic System Important Insurance Holders for the year 2023-2024. These insurance corporations, namely Life Insurance Corporation of India, General Insurance Corporation of India and New India Insurance Company Limited, have retained their D-SII status since last year.
 - Members of the Parliament of Unbelievers have achieved an important milestone by approving the marriage. Due to which the country has become a leader in Southeast Asia by legalizing equal rights. Dissidents from the Assembly of Lords have left an exception to legalize gay marriage, a significant step towards legalizing homosexuality in Southeast Asia. The law amending the Civil and Commercial Codes received overwhelming support in the House of Representatives.
 - Under the leadership of Rajya Sabha Deputy Chairman Harivansh Narayan Singh, the Indian Parliamentary Association along with its Armenian counterparts organized the Inter Parliamentary Association event in Geneva. The Armenian Lieutenant-General was represented by Deputy Speaker of the National Assembly, Hakob Arshasyan.
