- The nominees for the 81st annual Golden Globe
  Awards have been announced, setting the tone for
  the highly anticipated 2024 awards season. The
  unveiling not only showcased the industry's top talent, but also marked a significant moment in the
  history of the Golden Globes, a ceremony that has
  undergone significant changes in recent times.
- The Defense Research and Development Organization has decided to stop missile testing from February to March at Wheeler Island off the Odisha coast. Wheeler Island is adjacent to the Gahrimatha Sanctuary, considered to be the birthplace of Olive Ridley turtles. The Defense Research and Development Organization operates two major missile test ranges in Odisha.
- ♦ IIC has announced the names of the players selected as Male and Female Player of the Month for November 2023. The Men's Player of the Month award has been given to Travis Head, who scored a century in the World Cup final, while Bangladesh's spinner Nahida Akhtar has been awarded the ICC Women's Player of the Month award.
- ★ Kabir Bedi has been honored with The Order of Merit of Italy. Kabir Bedi has spread his acting skills not only in Hindi cinema but all over the world. Kabir is also very famous in Italy. He has worked in many Italian films.
- According to the study, the carbon emitted by developed and developing countries has revealed the existing disparity between the countries. The report is titled The Emissions Divide: Inequality Across Countries and Income Classes.
- ♦ Retail inflation rose to a three-month high of 5.55% in November due to rising food prices. According to the data released by NSO, inflation based on Consumer Price Index was at 4.87% in October. Inflation rate has been declining since August.
- ♦ India voted in favor of the resolution demanding Gaza ceasefire in the United Nations.

- India has decided to postpone the Quad summit originally scheduled for January 2024, citing scheduling disputes for some Quad partners. The summit includes participation from India, Australia, the US and Japan. Initially anticipated as the chief guest of India's Republic Day celebrations, US President Joe Biden is unlikely to attend the Quad summit due to rescheduling.
- Tata Power EV Charging Solutions Limited and Indian Oil Corporation Limited have signed an MoU to deploy over 500 EV charging points across the country. In a significant step towards strengthening the electric vehicle infrastructure in India, Tata Power EV Charging Solutions Limited has entered into an MoU with Indian Oil Corporation Limited. The collaboration aims to set up more than 500 EV charging points across the country with a focus on building a strong intercity charging network.
