# History of 5th April

- 1930: Mahatma Gandhi reached Dandi with his followers to break the salt law.
- ♦ 1949 : Bharat Scouts and Guides was established in 1949.
- ♦ 1964 : The Navy celebrated National Maritime Day for the first time.
- ◆ 1961: The first Indian Drugs and Pharmaceutical Limited Company sponsored by the Government of India was established.
- ♦ 1979: The country's first naval museum opened in Mumbai.
- ♦ 1479 : Guru Amardas, the third Guru of the Sikhs, was born.

## **Current Affairs Related to 5th April**

- Patton, POTA, Secretary, Ministry of Transport and Waterways, Shri T.K. Ramachandran pins Marchant Navy tag to Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in New Delhi, kicking off the week-long celebrations for National Maritime Day on April 5. Shri Shyam Jagannathan and other senior officials of Pot Transport Depot were also present on the occasion. Apart from this, a memento of the Prime Minister was also engraved. National Maritime Week, running from March 29 to April 5, pays tribute to the invaluable contribution of seafarers.
- The Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas recently inaugurated India's first small scale Liquefied Natural Gas unit at GAIL Limited's Vijaypur complex in Madhya Pradesh. This development is part of the government's broader initiative to promote the use of natural gas in various sectors and increase its share in the country's primary energy mix to 15% by 2030. The primary component of natural gas is methane, which accounts for 70.90% of its composition.
- Despite widespread criticism over its poor record on women's rights, Saudi Arabia has been elected to the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women. Saudi Ambassador Abdul Aziz Alwasil's outcry has sparked nominations in the community, given the huge outcry among state enterprises and commissions for promoting gender equality.
- The country's central banking institution, the Reserve Bank of India, is entering its 90th year. To dramatize this important occasion, Prime Minister Narendra Modi is attending the event at the National Center for Performing Arts in Mumbai. The Royal Commission on Indian Currency and Finance was established after 1A 1934 to maintain the economic stability of the country. It began operation on 1 April 1935 with Sir Osborne Smith as its first governor.

- A new task force has been constituted to explore biochar integration for the purpose of carbon dioxide based scrap generation in the captive sector of India. Established on 5 December 2023, it is focused on harnessing the potential of biochar. The Government of India has taken proactive steps to launch carbon emissions in the industry by setting up a task force to investigate the use of biochar. With the privatized sector making a significant contribution to industrial gas equipment, this initiative aims to reduce carbon emissions and promote sustainability in commercial manufacturing.
- Holi Singh and Atiyasa Tete have been named Players of the Year for 2023 in the men's and women's categories respectively at the sixth annual Hockey India Awards. During the event, Hockey India announced the revival of the Hockey India League, which will return in January 2025 after 2017. The revived league, featuring eight men's records and six women's records, is expected to take place after the Paris Olympics.
- Bank Metals has decided to stock 100 percent of the stocks. The bank said in the information given to the stock market that the sale will be done through Swiss Challenge. According to the information, an agreement has been reached with an interested party in this regard. A stand-alone offer is intended to serve as a base bid to elicit counter offers from other interested candidates.
- 6 new sites of Madhya Pradesh were included in the tentative UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites. The sites included in the new list include Gwalior Fort, historical group of Bhojeshwar Mahadev temples of Dhamnar, rock art sites of Chambal valley, Khooni Bhandara, Burhanpur and Gond monuments of Ramnagar, Mandla.
- India's unprecedented construction boom has created new opportunities for economic growth and improved living standards, but it has also created major environmental challenges.
