Current Affairs Related to 15 January

- Union Minister Piyush Goyal launched the logo for the India Mobility Global Expo 2024, highlighting India's innovative approach, scheduled for February 1-3, 2024 in New Delhi. Union Minister Piyush Goyal unveiled the logo and booklet for the muchawaited India Mobility Global Expo 2024 at an inaugural event in New Delhi.1.Held on 3 February 2024 at Bharat Mandapam, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi, the expo will include over 600 exhibitors from over 50 countries.
- ♦ The Securities and Exchange Board of India announced the appointment of G Rama Mohan Rao as Executive Director for a tenure of three years. With over 25 years of experience in SEBI, Rao brings a wealth of expertise to his new role. In his capacity as ED, he will oversee the Investigation Department and Internal Inspection Department, strengthening SEBI's commitment to maintaining market integrity.
- The Government of India under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has launched an ambitious initiative called PRITHVI, a comprehensive scheme of the Ministry of Earth Sciences. With a significant budget of Rs 4797 crore, the program will run from 2021-2026, marking a new era in the study and understanding of Earth Sciences in India. PRITHVI scheme aims to revolutionize our understanding and interaction with various Earth systems.
- The Union Cabinet has approved the Mera Yuva Bharat Autonomous Organization. This platform will provide youth with a range of tools, resources and opportunities to develop their skills, participate in social impact projects and contribute to governance. Union Minister Anurag Thakur gave this information and said that this will help in making India a developed nation. Its objective is to transform youth into community change agents and nation builders, making them youth bridges between the government and the rest of the citizens.

- There has been a record increase in the country's foreign exchange reserves. Foreign exchange reserves are continuously increasing. The country's foreign exchange reserves increased by \$2.76 billion to reach \$623.2 billion. Reserve Bank of India gave this information. Due to this, the total foreign exchange reserves of the country had increased by \$4.47 billion to \$620.44 billion in the last week. Amidst the pressure caused by global developments since last year, the central bank used capital reserves for necessary intervention in the market. This affected the currency reserves.
- The United Nations has said that India's growth rate is expected to be 6.2 percent in 2024 due to strong domestic demand and strong growth in manufacturing and services sectors. The United Nations' World Economic Situation and Prospects 2024 report states that GDP in South Asia is projected to grow by 5.2 percent in 2024. According to the report, India's GDP is expected to increase by 6.6 percent in 2025. The report said manufacturing and services sectors will continue to support the economy, but agricultural output is likely to be affected by irregular rainfall patterns.
- The newly developed integrated web portal of ERNET India for educational institutions was launched by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. The portal will provide domain registration, DNS and value added services. This web portal has been developed using open source software and emerging technologies like AI/ML.ERNET India is providing web accessibility services, campus Wi-Fi services, smart classrooms and connectivity to educational and research institutions through terrestrial and satellite systems.
- ♦ The Indian Space Research Organization successfully tested a fuel cell that uses hydrogen and oxygen to generate electricity in space. These cells will be very useful for human space missions because they produce heat and water as by-products.
