History of 6th May

- ◆ 1529: Babar, the rulers of Bengal and Bihar were defeated in the battle of Ghaghra.
- 1967: Zakir Hussain became the first Muslim President of India.
- ♦ 2004 : China accepted it as a part of India.
- ♦ 2010 : Ajmal Aamir Kasab, convicted of the 26/11 attacks in Mumbai in 2010, was sentenced to death.
- ♦ 1946: Bholabhai, a staunch jurist, prominent parliamentary leader and trusted aide of Mahatma Gandhi, passed away.

Current Affairs Related to 6th May 2024

- The Ministry of Earth Sciences will host the 46th Antarctic Treaty Consultative Meeting and the 26th meeting of the Environment Protection Committee in Kochi, Kerala. It will be organized from 20 to 30 May 2024 for a global dialogue on environmental management, scientific cooperation and collaboration in Antarctica. This year, more than 350 delegates from over 60 countries are expected to participate in the 46th ATCM and 26th CEP.
- ↑ There has been a demand by telecom industry body COAI to ban the sale of Wi-Fi 6E routers that use the 6 GHz spectrum band for data transmission. However, the government has not yet decided on the use of these frequencies. The Cellular Operators Association of India has alleged that various offline merchants and ecommerce platforms, such as Amazon, Flipkart and Moglix, are selling such routers.
- ◆ Defense Research and Development Organization conducted flight test of Supersonic Missile Assisted Release of Torpedo. Its main objective is to increase the anti-submarine warfare capabilities of the Navy. It is equipped with several advanced subsystems, including a two-stage solid propulsion system, an electromechanical actuator system and a precision inertial navigation system.
- ♦ According to a petroleum file in the Government Stock Review, the Indian Cultural Energy Development Agency is a public sector corporation that has been awarded the prestigious Navratna status by the government. This prestigious degree takes the total number of Navratna PSEs in India to 17. PTMC with Navratna status. Receives significant ownership and financial credit. The company will now have the right to invest up to Rs 1000 crore without prior approval from the government.
- ♦ The Indian Vaccine Manufacturers Association has announced the appointment of Krishna Ella, cofounder and executive chairman of Bharat Biotech, as its new president for the next two years in April 2024.

- The BWF World Junior Badminton Championships in 2025 will be hosted by the National Center of Excellence in Guwahati. This was announced during the BWF Annual General Meeting in Chengdu on the sidelines of the BWF Thomas & Uber Cup 2024. India's image as one of the leading centers of world badminton will be further boosted. This prestigious tournament, which India will host for the second time, will be held in the new state-of-the-art National Center of Excellence.
- ♦ The Indian Air Force and Indian Navy have strengthened their combat aircraft with the induction of Radhanez Long Range supersonic air-to-base missiles, which were previously used by the Israeli Air Force in operations against the Iranian Air Force. The missile, known within the Indian Air Force as Hi-Rocket Mark 2, offers a range of up to 250 km.
- ♣ In India, the number of carnivorous birds is decreasing faster than that of omnivorous birds. This shows the effect of diet on bird populations. According to reports, 942 bird species that feed on fruits and nectar are thriving across the country. This success is attributed to the availability of these resources, which remain in abundance even in highly modified rural and urban landscapes.
- ♦ ISRO scientists have found evidence of the possibility of water ice in the polar crater of the Moon in a study. Scientists from ISRO's Space Applications Center conducted a study titled Access and Origin of Water Ice on the Moon in collaboration with researchers from IIT Kanpur, University of Southern California, Jet Propulsion Laboratory and IIT Dhanbad.
- ♦ The world's deepest blue hole has been discovered by Mexican researchers, but the problem is that they have not been able to reach it yet. The site, named Tam Ja Blue Hole, is now the deepest known underwater sinkhole in the world.






