History of 3rd April

- ◆ 1984 : Rakesh Sharma became the first Indian astronaut to go to space in the Russian spacecraft Soyuz T-11.
- ♦ 1999 : India launched the first global logistics satellite INSAT 1E.
- 1903 : Freedom fighter and social reformer Kamla Devi Chattopadhyay was born.
- 1680: Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, the founder of the Maratha Empire in India, died in Raigarh.

Current Affairs Related to 3rd April

- In the financial year 2025, the GNPA ratio of scheduled commercial banks will improve to 2.1.2.4%. GNPA ratio of SCB has been declining since March 2019. The gross non-performing assets ratio of scheduled commercial banks has fallen to 3.9% in FY 2023, which is the lowest level in a decade. The asset quality has improved due to higher write offs by recovery banks, much less slippage etc.
- ♦ A database launched by India to record crimes against UN peacekeepers. This new database is designed to record crimes against UN peacekeepers and monitor progress in holding perpetrators accountable. This database will act as an online repository, empowering the Secretariat missions. It will help Member States to monitor and resolve cases of malicious acts against peacekeepers.
- An MoU was signed between India's leading space consortium SIA India and Brazil's leading satellite communications consortium ABRSAT. The objective of this cooperation is to increase cooperation and progress in the space sector of both the countries. The MoU also aims to explore new market dynamics, infrastructure development and private investment, thereby providing a platform to industry leaders to capitalize on the emerging potential.
- ♦ The Armed Forces Act 1958 was extended by the Central Government to eight districts of Nagaland and 21 police stations in five districts. The Central Government declared them as disturbed areas for a period of six months, unless earlier withdrawn.
- PR Sreejesh and Camilla Carrom have been appointed as co-chairs of the new FIH Athlete Committee of the International Hockey Federation. The FIH Athletes Committee plays the role of an advisory body.

- The lower house of France's parliament has passed a bill that would ban discrimination based on hair texture, length, color or style. This bill will amend existing anti-discrimination measures in the Labor Code. This bill will support Black people who face discrimination in the workplace because of their hair. This bill has been approved by 44 MLAs, while two have voted against it. This will become law after the approval of the Senate.
- LIC, GIC RE and New India Assurance Company will continue as domestic systemically important insurers. LIC and New India are the largest life and general insurance companies in India. GIC Re is the only Indian reinsurer. The failure of these DSIIs would disturb the domestic financial system.
- ◆ India and Ukraine held talks focused on conflict resolution to strengthen bilateral relations. The talks held at Hyderabad House focused on the ongoing conflict and its wider implications.
- ♦ \$3.63 billion was invested in Indian equities by foreign institutional investors in March. This was their biggest buying activity since December 2023. Overall, they made market investments of about Rs 52,467 crore, hitting a four-year high. Apart from India, FI chose to invest in Taiwan, Indonesia and South Korea.
 - President Draupadi Murmu presented Bharat Ratna awards to former Prime Ministers Chaudhary Charan Singh and PV Narasimha Rao, former Bihar Chief Minister Karpuri Thakur, eminent scientist MS Swaminathan and Deputy Prime Minister LK Advani. Lal Krishna Advani will be honored with Bharat Ratna at his residence. PV Prabhakar Rao received the award from the President on behalf of his father PV Narasimha Rao.
