## History of December 19

- ♦ 1927: Great freedom fighters Ram Prasad Bismil, Ashfaqullah Khan and Roshan Singh were hanged by the British.
- ♦ 1961 : Indian troops entered Goa under Operation Vijay.
- 2008 : Canara Bank, HDFC and Bank of Rajasthan announced to make housing loans cheaper.

## **Current Affairs Related to 19 December**

- ♦ Veteran lyricist screenwriter Javed Akhtar will be honored with the Padyapani Lifetime Achievement Award at the Ajanta Ellora Film Festival. The award ceremony will be held at Rukmini Auditorium of MGM University campus. The main objective of this festival is to showcase the best films produced in the recent past. It will be organized till 3-7 January 2024
- The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has launched the Indian Forest and Wood Certification Scheme. This voluntary national certification initiative aims to encourage sustainable forest management and agroforestry practices in India. The scheme covers forest management certification, tree outside forest management certification and chain of custody certification.
- All 29 member countries of the Global Partnership on Artificial Intelligence summit adopted the New Delhi Declaration. They agreed to collaboratively develop AI applications in health care and agriculture. GPAI will be a hub for shaping the future of Artificial Intelligence in terms of innovation and collaboration between partner countries. According to the announcement, GPAI will also focus on countries in the Global South and provide the benefits of AI platforms and solutions to all people in the world.
- According to Mercer's 2023 Quality of Life Index, Pune boasts the second best quality of life in India after Hyderabad. Pune has ranked second best in terms of quality of life in India in the recent ranking of Living Quality Index 2023 by Mercer, a renowned global consultancy for businesses. The city is slightly behind Hyderabad, which marks a significant improvement from the previous ranking.
- The brand value of the Indian Premier League increased by 28 percent to \$ 10.7 billion. This was stated in a report released by Brand Finance. With this growth the league has attained Dekacorn status. As of now, the brand value of IPL is \$10.7 billion.

- The Unique Identification Authority of India has taken strict action against operators found guilty of overcharging and has also imposed a fine of Rs 50,000 against them. The move is aimed at ensuring fair and accessible services to all citizens, Minister of State for Electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrashekhar said, detailing these measures in a written reply in the Lok Sabha.
- The Chief Election Commissioner and Other Election Commissioners Bill 2023 has been passed by the Rajya Sabha. This bill replaces the Election Commission Act 1991. The Bill provides for the appointment, salary and removal of the Chief Election Commissioner and Election Commissioners. According to the provisions of the Bill, the President will appoint the CEC and EC on the recommendation of a selection committee.
- Central Universities Bill, 2023 passed in Parliament. The Bill will amend the Central Universities Act 2009, which establishes central universities for teaching and research in various states. The Bill provides for setting up a Central Tribal University in Telangana. It will be named Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University. It will provide opportunities for higher education and research facilities mainly to the tribal population of India.
- India's first six lane steel slag based road was constructed connecting NH.6 to Hazira Port. Steel slag is generated as solid waste during steel production. Approximately 180.200 kg of steel slag is generated per tonne of steel production. The Ministry of Steel has funded a R&D project on development of design guidelines and specifications for the use of steel slag in road construction.

For the first time, agreement was reached at the COP28 climate summit to reduce the use of fossil fuels. They agreed to prevent the worst effects of climate change and it is the first agreement of its kind, signaling the end of the oil era.
