Current Affairs Related to 13 December

- According to Social Justice Minister Virendra Kumar, the Central Government is considering a proposal to determine equivalence of posts in State Government PSUs with Central Government posts for recruitment under OBC reservation.
- Loan agreement signed to improve road connectivity in the state of Madhya Pradesh. The loan agreement was signed by Ms. Juhi Mukherjee, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Finance, on behalf of the Government of India, and Takeo Konishi, Country Director, ADB India Resident Mission, on behalf of ADB. This project will enhance connectivity in the state road network in 14 districts to enable balanced economic development in Madhya Pradesh. The project will convert approximately 500 km of state highways and major district roads into standard two-lane roads.
- ♦ Bollywood actress Huma Qureshi has ventured into new territory as a writer, making her debut with a novel titled Zeba An Accidental Superhero. The book was officially launched during the 12th edition of the Bangalore Literature Festival, marking a new chapter in Huma Qureshi's creative journey.
- ◆ Union Women and Child Development Minister Smriti Irani said this in a written reply to a question in the Rajya Sabha. Assam and Union Territory Jammu and Kashmir have been selected to implement it in the first phase. In Jammu and Kashmir, it is being implemented in two aspirational districts Kupwara and Baramulla. In Assam, it is being implemented in seven districts: Barpeta, Goalpara, South Salmara Mankachar, Udalguri, Darrang, Morigaon and Kamrup.
- ♦ The fourth phase of the Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum Solar Park was inaugurated by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai. It is the world's largest concentrated solar power project using three hybrid technologies.
- Mera Gaon Meri Dharohar Project launched by Ministry of Culture


- UAE's Mohammed Al Ramsi appointed as Chairman of the World Radiocommunication Conference 2023. This appointment marks the fulfillment of the decision taken by the WRC during its last session in Sharm el Sheikh, Egypt in 2019. The conference will run till December 15 in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. The objective of organizing the conference is to review the global use of radio frequency spectrum in orbit, geostationary satellites and nongeostationary satellites.
- Four notable Indian celebrities have made it to the latest release of Forbes' annual list of the world's most powerful women. - Google's parent company Alphabet made an important announcement by unveiling its latest and most advanced AI model to date, Gemini. Gemini represents a huge leap forward for the tech giant in the rapidly growing field of artificial intelligence, outpacing competitors like Open AI's GPT-4 and Meta's Llama 2.
