Current Affairs Related to 15th March

- ♦ Shri Rajiv Chandrashekhar, Minister of State for IT & Electronics, Skill Development, Entrepreneurship and Jal Shakti inaugurated India's first FutureLab Construction Center at C-DAC Thiruvananthapuram. This center named Center for Semiconductor Chips and Systems for Strategic Electronics will play an important role in fostering an ecosystem for next generation chip design, communication and research. Other announcements include announcement of collaboration between C-DAC and Ministry of Railways for development of electric locomotive technology.
- ↑ Tata Power Solar Systems has commissioned a 100 capacity solar project with battery energy storage system in Rajnandgaon, Chhattisgarh. The battery energy storage system has a capacity of 120 wagons. Tata Power Solar Systems December 2021 Noida, August 20 A project worth Rs 945 crore was received on the basis of EPC.
- Simdega district of Jharkhand hosted the national level agricultural science fair, Pusa Science Agricultural Fair. For the first time, Pusa Agro Industries, a national level agro industry, was hosted in Simdega district of Jharkhand. The objective of the fair is to promote modern agricultural technology and entrepreneurship among farmers. Union Agriculture Minister Arjun Munda stressed the government's focus on increasing the income of farmers.
- Both NT PC and its community energy arm CNGL signed non-government agreements with Rajasthan State Electricity Generation Corporation Limited in Jaipur. These represent a significant advancement towards improving the plant and cost effectiveness of Chapada Thermal Power Plant. The focus has been on the path to redesigning supercritical units at Stylist Supermarkets to modernize and increase power generation.

- The James Webb Space Telescope has captured the oldest known dead galaxy.
- The Indian Statistical Commission has approved the merger of North Small East Finance Bank with Garagepreneurs Internet Private Limited, a finance company. This named move aims to consolidate the strengths of both in the financial services sector. The proposed merger of JIPEL comprises the proposed company consisting of its subsidiaries Electronics Finance Pvt Ltd and Intergalactic Foundry Pvt Ltd, with NY SBB and its subsidiary RGVN McFinance Ltd.
- ▶ India was the world's top arms exporter for the period 2019-2023, according to the latest data from the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute. India's tourism sector is estimated to grow by 4.7% compared to the period 2014-2018. Russia has become India's main arms manufacturer, accounting for 36% of its stake, the report said, the first five-year period since 1960-1964.
 - Government notified Uniform Code for Pharmaceutical Marketing Practices. Its purpose is to prevent unethical practices within the pharmaceutical industry, which may affect healthcare professionals. The central government has allowed companies to arrange medical education workshops and provide research grants for health care professionals, provided these are done in a transparent manner. The new guidelines prevent companies from holding continuing medical education workshops abroad.
 - PM Modi observed a joint display of indigenous defense equipment in the form of live fire and exercise Bharat Shakti of the three services in Pokhran, Rajasthan. Indigenous weapons and platforms were showcased to showcase the country's strength. The exercise showcases the integrated operational capability of the Indian Armed Forces to deal with threats spanning land, air, sea, cyber and space domains.
