#### **History of 1st May**

- ◆ 1851 : Queen Victoria inaugurated the Great Exhibition in London.
- ♦ 1897 : Swami Vivekananda established the Ramakrishna Mission.
- ♦ 1972 : The country's coal mines were nationalized.
- ♦ 1923: The celebration in India started in Chennai. Earlier, there were 80 countries in India where May 1 was celebrated as Labor Day.
- ♦ 1960 : Maharashtra was declared a state.

#### Current Affairs Related to 1st May

- IREDA is now empowered to execute significant investments up to Rs 1000 crore without requiring approval from the central authority. Navratna status companies are allowed to allocate up to 30% of their total assets annually. Although it will be less than Rs 1000 crore. They also have the option to participate in joint ventures, form partnerships and set up foreign subsidiaries. To be eligible for Navratna status a corporation must obtain its Miniratna Category-1 designation.
- ♦ The Bureau of Financial Services has also recommended the appointment of Ashish Pandey to the post of MD and CEO in Indian Bank. Rana Ashutosh Kumar Singh is currently the Deputy Managing Director in SBI. At present SBI has four MDs. Alok Kumar Chaudhary's tenure as MD will end on June 30, 2024, when he will retire.
- ♦ Around 37,000 Bru migrants from Mizoram, now settled in Tripura, cast their votes in the Lok Sabha. He cast his vote in the Lok Sabha elections for the first time as a voter from Tripura. These Bru migrants are stranded in transit camps set up in North Tripura.
- Phi-3 Mini is the smallest AI model ever introduced by Microsoft. Just days after Meta unveiled its Llama 3 large language model, the latest version of the lightweight AI model Phi-3 Mini was unveiled by Microsoft. Microsoft describes Phi-3 as a family of open AI models that are the most capable and costeffective small language models available.
- Ministry of Mines organized important Mineral Summit in New Delhi. It is being organized in collaboration with Shakti Sustainable Energy Foundation, Council on Energy, Environment and Water and Indian Institute of Sustainable Development. Designed to help develop cooperation, share knowledge and promote innovation in the field of critical mineral beneficiation and processing in India.

- NABARD has partnered with RBIH to launch a system that will enable faster processing of agricultural loans. NABARD will integrate its e-Kisan Credit Card loan origination system portal with RBIH's Public Tech Platform for Frictionless Credit. Digitization of agricultural loans will ensure quick doorstep delivery of loans to farmers. NABARD Chairman Shaji K V and RBIH CEO Rajesh Bansal signed the partnership agreement.
- The Reserve Bank has notified amendments to the FEMA rules for listing an Indian company on international stock exchanges. These new rules will help companies use foreign exchange more effectively. The first set of rules deals with the manner of payment and reporting of non-debt instruments. In January, the government allowed direct listing of GIFT IFSCs by Indian companies on international exchanges.
- Petitions seeking 100% cross verification of electronic voting machines data with voter verifiable paper audit trail records were rejected by the Supreme Court of India. The bench of Justice Sanjeev Khanna and Dipankar Dutta gave this decision. This order was passed keeping in mind the reply given by the Election Commission.
- According to the Patent Trends Report released by NASSCOM, 83000 patents were filed in India in the year 2023, which is the highest in the last two decades. Between FY 2019 to FY 2023, the number of patents filed has seen a significant increase of more than 2 times.
- Narsingh Pancham Yadav has been elected chairman of the Wrestling Federation of India's Athletes Commission, a process mandated by the sport's world governing body. Arjuna Award winner and 2010 Asian Championships gold medalist Narsingh participated in the 2012 London Olympic Games and lost the preliminaries in the 74 kg category.
