### History of 8th July

- ♦ 1918: The Montague Chelmsford Report was published to reform the Indian Constitution.
- ◆ 1497: Vasco da Gama left Europe with a 170 meter high crew to reach India by sea.
- ◆ 1858 : Lord Canning had declared peace after the fall of Gwalior Fort.
- ◆ 1954: Prime Minister Jawaharlal launched the hydroelectric project on the Bhakra-Nagal of Punjab, the world's largest canal.

#### **Current Affairs Related to 8th July 2024**

- Air India is setting up South Asia's largest flight training school in Maharashtra's Amravati district with an investment of over Rs 200 crore. This school is going to appear in the first quarter of the next financial year. The initiative aims to secure a stable pipeline of pilots for the airline, which will require 500.700 pilots in 2023 to support its expansion plans following the mega order of 470 Airbus and 100 Boeing 700 aircraft.
- Nomadic Elephant exercise started in Umroi, Meghalaya. This is the 16th edition of the India-Mongolia joint military exercise Nomadic Elephant. This is a two-week training program which will end on July 16. Its objective is to improve communication between the troops of the two countries in semi-conventional operations in semi-urban and hilly areas. Every year this training program is alternated between Mongolia and India. The status of several bilateral defense cooperation projects was reviewed in the meeting.
- 25 countries including India participated in the third UN-led conference on Afghanistan. This meeting is important because for the first time the Taliban are participating in the talks. India was represented in this meeting by J.P. Singh, Joint Secretary, Pakistan, Afghanistan and Iran Division of the Ministry of External Affairs. The conference was strongly criticized by women's rights activists, who expressed concern over the plight of women in Afghanistan.
- India and Belarus held consular talks for the first time in Minsk. The welfare of Indian students in Belarus was also among the many consular issues discussed during the meeting. The meetings also focused on initiatives to increase tourism between the two countries. Both sides decided to follow up the discussions and review the progress in the next edition of the talks.

- State Bank of India has introduced a revolutionary online business solution called MSME Sahaj, which is tailor-made for MSMEs. This web-based platform allows MSMEs to avail loans against their GST registered sales faster and without any fraud. MSMEs have leveraged data from GSTIN, bank details and credit information companies to make seamless credit assessments. Its objective is to complete the functioning of MSMEs under the GST regime.
- A new banking malware called SnowBlind has targeted Android users to steal banking credentials. This malware uses a built-in security feature to bypass anti-tamper protection in apps that handle sensitive information. Snowblind uses a feature called SECAMP, which stands for secure computing.
- Bangladesh Navy and India's Garden Reach Ship-builders and Engineers signed an agreement for the 800 tonne seaplane. This agreement has been made under the \$500 million line of credit given by India to Bangladesh. As per the contract the ship will be handed over to Bangladesh within 24 months. This ship will be approximately 61 meters long and 15.80 meters wide, with a maximum speed of at least 13 knots. This deal will strengthen bilateral defense relations between India and Bangladesh.
- Akhilesh Pathak has taken charge as the new Chief General Manager of Southern Region Network System-1 of Power Grid Corporation of India Limited. Pike Touch will oversee the network system including sub-stations and projects in parts of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka. With over 31 years of experience in the virtual sector, he is in charge of operations and maintenance, short-term management and commercial operations.




