History of 12 April

Current Affairs Related to 12 April

- The United States and Britain have joined forces to strengthen safety measures surrounding upcoming advanced artificial fireworks on beaches. The collaboration, formalized through a Memorandum of Understanding, aims to develop an Advanced Group Model Test Park as part of a series of events organized during the Hotel Security Summit held at Bletchley.
- The Uttarakhand state government has suggested proactive measures to address and mitigate the risks associated with glacial lake outburst FLD. Two expert panels have been established to conduct risk assessments and monitor five high-risk glacial lakes in the region. These lakes are identified as emergency threats that require immediate attention and intervention.
- The line between judicial activism and judicial overreach was highlighted by former CJI Ranjan Gogoi. Former CJI Ranjan Gogoi distinguished between judicial activism and judicial overreach, saying it is the responsibility of the judiciary to know when to act as a catalyst for change and when to maintain the status quo. He also underlined the need for judicial systems to adapt to changing times, which is being recognized globally.
- Section 144 has been imposed to maintain peace and public order in Leh district of Ladakh. To take out any kind of procession, rally or march for the implementation of Section 144, written permission will have to be taken from the District Magistrate Office of Leh. It has also been ordered not to make any such statement which may disturb communal harmony and peace or create any problem related to law and order in the district. The ban came just two days before a proposed Pashmina march by climate activist Sonam Wangchuk in Changthang area to highlight the Union Territory's dwindling pasture land.

- India has lifted the ban on essential commodities like egg, potato onion, rice, wheat flour, sugar and pulses for the financial year 2024-2025. This step was taken to book passport stock between the two countries since November last year.
- Parivartan Chintan a tri-service conference was organized in New Delhi. The objective of this conference is to generate new ideas, reforms and initiatives to advance jointness and integration efforts. Chief of Defense Staff General Anil Chauhan presided over the day-long discussion. This was the first conference of all the tri-service institutions, Department of Military Affairs, Headquarters Integrated Defense Staff and Chiefs of the three services.
- A 32-member Congress campaign committee was approved by the AICC for the Lok Sabha elections in Rajasthan. Former Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot, Deputy CM Sachin Pilot, Congress candidates CP Joshi and Pratap Singh Khachariyawas have been included in this committee. Surprisingly, Arjun Singh Bamania, who was made the party candidate from Banswara but failed to file nomination, has also been included in the campaign committee.
- INS Sharda has been awarded the On the Spot Unit Citation by Admiral R Hari Kumar, Chief of the Naval Staff during his visit to the Southern Naval Command, Kochi. INS Sharda has been awarded this award for successfully conducting anti-piracy operations. INS Sharda participated in the safe release of all 19 crew members of the Iranian fishing vessel Omari.
- ◆ Triple world champion Red Bull's Max Verstappen built his library at the Japanese Grand Prix and gave his team a lead of two with teammate Sergio Perez. After a pole start, Verstappen remained in control throughout the race as he took his third win in the first four races of the 2024 season.


