### Current Affairs Related to 30th March 2024

- India plans to raise the minimum wage from a living wage by 2025. It is important to pay attention to important things like education and health, through living a virtuous life is ensured. India aims to replace its minimum wage with a living wage by 2025, with assistance being sought from the International Labor Organization for technical assistance to create and implement this transition.

- ♦ ISRO's PSLV Orbital Experimental Module-3 reentered the Earth's atmosphere without leaving any trace in orbit. ISRO said that this milestone had been achieved. After successfully placing all the satellites in their designated orbits, the last stage of PSLV has been converted into POEM 3 in 3 axis stabilized platform.
- ♦ A recent report released by the Kathmandu-based International Center for Integrated Mountain Development and the Australian Water Partnership stressed the need for multilateral treaties for effective integrated river basin management of the Indus, Ganga and Brahaputra rivers.


- External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar visited Indian Coast Guard Ship Samudra Pehredar. They are in Manila Bay, Philippines as part of overseas deployment to ASEAN countries. The ships are on overseas deployment to ASEAN countries, the Philippines, Vietnam and Brunei from 25 March to 12 April. This is the third consecutive deployment of the Indian Coast Guard to ASEAN countries.
- Senior lawyer Abhay Thakur has been appointed as the next Ambassador of India to Myanmar. He is currently working as Officer on Special Duty in the Ministry of External Affairs. This was announced by the Ministry of External Affairs. Abhay Thakur is a 1992 batch officer of the Indian Foreign Service. He served as the Sum Sherpa for the G20 process as India chairs the influential group of 20 major economies.
