History of 9th April

- ♦ 1669: Emperor Aurangzeb of the Mughal Empire ordered the demolition of all Hindu schools and temples.
- ♦ 1965 : Battle broke out between the Indian and Pakistani armies in the Rann of Kutch.
- ♦ 2004: The Supreme Court of Portugal asked to review the extradition order of wanted mafia leader Abu Salem to India in several criminal cases in India.
- ♦ 1838 : The National Art Gallery was opened in London.

Current Affairs Related to 9th April 2024

- The World Bank Group has appointed former Reserve Bank of India Deputy Governor Rakesh Mohan as a member of its Economic Advisory Panel. The panel will include Lord Nicholas Stern, IG Patel Professor of Economics and Government, London School of Arts. Indermit Gill, Chief Economist of the World Bank Group, will co-chair the panel. Rakesh Mohan is currently based in New Delhi as Emeritus President and Distinguished Fellow at the think tank Center for Social and Unique Progress.
- ♦ Governor Shaktikanta Das announced that a decision has been taken with a 5:1 majority to stabilize the policy lake. He also said that there has been a steady decline in the main designation. This is the first bi-monthly statue policy of 2024-2025. The Governor of the Reserve Bank of India also announced the continuation of MSF and Bank 6.75%.
- Union Health Ministry has launched MyCGHS iOS app. The MyCGHS app for iOS ecosystem of devices has been released by Shri Apoorva Chandra, Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The Central Government Health Scheme App aims to improve beneficiaries' access to electronic health records, data and resources. The technical teams of National Informatics Center Himachal Pradesh and NIC Health team are responsible for developing the app.
- ↑ The Indian government has given onion share to friendly countries like Bangladesh, United Arab Emirates, Bahrain, Mauritius and Bhutan. After the ban on onion in December 2023, the government has taken this decision by accepting the proposal of Indian onion from these friendly countries.
- ♦ Forbes has released its annual list of the world's billionaires for 2024, revealing that the list includes more people than ever before and that they are richer than ever. In this, there are 141 more billionaires in the world than last year, whose total number is 2781.

- The Defense and Development Organization has launched a project to set up a testing center in Junput village in West Bengal for weapons exploration in the country. The objective of this initiative is to offer an additional operational area in the built trial range at Silverpur in Odisha to demonstrate coal mines. 8.73 Poster near Digha The objective of this site is to facilitate timely testing of weapons in view of the importance of such assessments in the defense and security sector.
- The Center for Cellular and Molecular Platforms has developed OptiDrop, a new platform for studying single cells. This platform has potential applications in diagnostics, therapeutics, science, agriculture and animal health. This microfluidic chip based platform will allow optical sensing of biological samples without expensive open space. It will be able to study single cells contained in droplets with ease and accuracy.
- ♦ According to Forbes' 38th annual World Billionaires
 List 2024, Reliance Industries Limited Chairman and
 Managing Director Mukesh Ambani is the first panIndian to make it to the list of world's top 10 billionaires. The units were ranked 9th on the list, topped
 by Bernard Arnoult andfamily, owner of French giant LVMH.
- ◆ Juan Vicente Pérez Mora was certified as the world's oldest person in 2022. He was officially declared the oldest living person on 4 February 2022, when he was aged 112 years and 253 day
- Dr. Kommuri was awarded the prestigious Overseas Dental Specialist title at the National Fame Awards 2024 held at The Club, Mumbai. Reputed for providing excellent patient care, Dr. Karthik Kommuri is a fine example of modern orthodontics and dentistry practices.
