## History of 28th July

- ◆ 1858 : Painting print was first used by Sir William James Herschel of the Indian Railway Service.
- ♦ 1983 : NASA launched the commercial communications satellite Telstar-3A.
- ♦ 2005: The tenth planet of the solar system was

claimed to be discovered.

- 2008 : India's External Affairs Minister Pranab Mukherjee visited Tehran to attend the meeting of the Council of Ministers of the Non-Aligned State.
- ◆ 1914: The first Pehalwan war started.

## **Current Affairs Related to 28th July 2024**

- The Climate Finance Action Fund will receive annual contributions from fossil fuel producing countries and companies. This fund will help developing countries as well as other countries to reach the 1.5°C temperature target. Initially \$1 billion will be raised through members as a fixed amount or with annual contribution based on production volume. COP29 will be held in Baku from 11 to 22 November in 2024.
- Sikkim has made it mandatory for tourist vehicles to carry garbage bags. This decision has been taken to ensure community participation in achieving the goal of environmental sustainability. It will be the responsibility of tour operators, travel agencies and vehicle drivers to inform tourists about using garbage bags for garbage disposal. Awareness campaigns will be conducted to educate tourists about waste management and environmental sustainability.
- ◆ The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities has signed these MoUs to empower the persons with disabilities socially, educationally and economically. During the signing of the agreements, Union Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment Dr. Virendra Kumar and Minister of State in the Ministry B.L. Verma was present. The MoU reflects the government's commitment towards persons with disabilities.
- ♦ The Economic Survey highlighted for the first time the mental health issue and its importance and implications for policy recommendations. It notes that overall economic status and mental health disorders are related to productivity loss due to absenteeism, decreased productivity, disability, and increased health care costs.
- ♦ A letter of intent was signed by Atal Innovation Mission of NITI Aayog and World Intellectual Property Organization in New Delhi. This MoU was signed to create joint programs towards innovation, entrepreneurship and intellectual property for the countries of the Global South.

- Indian hockey goalkeeper PR Sreejesh, who has played an important role in the game, has announced that he will retire from international hockey after the Paris Olympics 2024.
- In a bid to boost India's goal of a self-reliant India, global giant Airbus has said it is teaming up with its Indian arm Tata to set up a final assembly line for H-125 helicopters in upcoming real estate. European aircraft major Airbus has selected eight locations in India to set up its final assembly line for B125 helicopters.
- BCCI Secretary Jay Shah said the Board of Control for Cricket in India has offered Rs 8.5 crore to the Indian Olympic Association in support of the Indian contingent. This team will represent the country in the upcoming 2024 Paris Olympics. India will have the least number of athletes in Paris compared to the Tokyo Olympics held three years ago. However, the total team size will be larger. This is because there will be a higher number of coaches and other support staff who will accompany the players for Olympic glory.
- State-owned company Hello Meghalaya launched a community lake primarily for regional beaches with limited access or small markets. Shri Sangma said Hello Meghalaya is envisioned as a global destination for our talented young local musicians, film artistes and creative creators across various sectors.
- Atal Innovation Mission in NITI Aayog and World Stock Exchange launched Hand Portfolio towards creating a United Innovation Program in the Global South. Union Education and Skill Development Minister Democrat Pradhan said that innovation is India's strength. This ground-breaking collaboration between AIM and WIPO brings India's innovation models to the United Nations, which is on a similar development path, and will increase understanding and awareness about Intellectual Property Rights right from the school level.
